TITLE 1 – CODIFICATION

CHAPTER 1 – TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known, cited and referred to as the "CITY OF SPRING GROVE CODIFICATION ORDINANCE" except as referenced to herein, where it shall be known as "this Code."

CHAPTER 2 – ADOPTION

- A. At the July 20, 2004, city council meeting the City of Spring Grove city council did adopt certain revisions, codifications and new ordinances. A compilation of this action is entitled City of Spring Grove Code of Ordinances.
- B. In their interpretation and application, the provisions of this Code shall be held to be the minimum requirements for the promotion of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare of the community.
- C. Where the conditions imposed by any provision of this Code are either more restrictive or less restrictive than comparable conditions imposed by any other law, ordinance, statute, resolution, or regulations of any kind, the regulations which are more restrictive, or which impose higher standards or requirements shall prevail.

CHAPTER 3 – REPEALS

All ordinances of a general and permanent nature enacted on or before July 20, 2004, are hereby repealed. The repeal provided for shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part thereof that has been repealed by a subsequent ordinance that is repealed by this Code.

CHAPTER 4 – COPIES

The city clerk shall provide a sufficient quantity of the City of Spring Grove Code of Ordinances for general distribution to the public and shall give notice that copies for examination are available at City Hall and at the Spring Grove Library, also that copies for purchase are available at City Hall.

CHAPTER 5 – PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE

The City of Spring Grove Code of Ordinances shall be prima facie evidence of the law of the City.

CHAPTER 6 – EFFECTIVE DATE.
